### **Friday – 1**

Please pray that the Russian President will not sign the anti-missionary law that was passed by parliament June 24. Pray for freedom in Russia to continue.

### **Saturday – 2**

Religious freedoms in Russia is being restricted more and more. Please pray that this latest anti-missionary legislation will not hamper FEBC's ministry.

### **Sunday – 3**

Please pray that FEBC can continue to minister in Russia despite multiple new restrictions such as the new anti-missionary law. Hundreds of Russian churches are praying and fasting that the law would not be signed by President Putin.

### **Monday – 4**

Please pray for FEBC's ministry in Russia as we are dealing with harsh restrictions imposed on us by Russian lawmakers. Pray that God will intercede so that many more people will come to faith.

### **Tuesday – 5**

Please pray for Alexey Vlasihin, FEBC manager in St. Petersburg, and all of our broadcasters there. Pray that God will bless their programs and families. Pray, too, for their listeners who need salvation in Jesus Christ.

### **Wednesday – 6**
