

FEBC Russian Ministries Prayer Focus June 2015

Monday – 1

PRAYER FOCUS: Please pray for Rudi Wiens, who oversees FEBC's ministry in Central Asia. He will be in Almaty and Bishkek the beginning of June. Safety and God's presence is needed for all his travels. Meetings and interviews with listeners are scheduled.

Tuesday – 2

PRAYER FOCUS: Please pray for Janysh, FEBC's station manager in Bishkek, who is busy with details for the new FM relay station in Issyk-Kul area. We hope to be on the air sometime during Fall 2015.

Wednesday – 3
