This year, numerous Christian organizations in Russia were inspected by district attorneys and the police; FEBC was among them, again. We are still continuing to bring the Good News to millions of Russian people. Please pray for freedom, while limited, to continue through the critical 2018 election year.

### **Monday – 2**

Please pray for Rudi Wiens as he continues to develop FEBC's ministry in Central Asia. Pray for God's wisdom and blessings on his work. Also, pray for blessings and protection for all staff and their families in Kyrgyzstan and Kazakhstan, which are Muslim-dominant countries.

Please pray for Lyudmila Aleksandrova, an FEBC broadcaster in St. Petersburg. Pray for her health; she is suffering from pain in her eye. Pray that God will heal Lyudmila and bless her life.
