



FEBC Russian Ministries Prayer Focus September 2015

Tuesday – 1

Victor Kurilenko, FEBC's director in Slavyansk, Eastern Ukraine, asked us to pray for peace in the country. War continues and approximately 30,000 refugees have moved to Slavyansk. Pray that many non-believers there will come to know the Lord through FEBC broadcasts.

Wednesday – 2

Please pray for Rudi Wiens, FEBC's regional coordinator. Pray for God's blessings in his work, as he coordinates the development of FEBC's ministry in Central Asia. Also, pray for all our staff in Kyrgyzstan and Kazakhstan.

Thursday – 3

Our listener from Kazakhstan, Anara, asked us to pray for her relatives who are not followers of Jesus. Many are traditional Muslims. Recently, Anara's younger brother who was a Christian passed away, and the funeral ceremony has become a volatile issue. Traditional Muslims have been told not to attend a Christian funeral. Please pray that this situation will make many of Anara's relatives more open to the Gospel. Believers within the extended family are often persecuted by their own family members. Pray for God's protection as well.

Friday – 4

Please pray for Alexey Vlasihin, director of FEBC-St. Petersburg, and the staff. Pray that many non-believers will find freedom in Christ through their broadcasts. Also, pray for Alexey's family: Alexey and his wife Natasha have two little children.

Local officials often look for all kinds of reasons to persecute those who, according to them, “betray” their traditional faith. Several churches have already been closed due to unimportant reasons. Nevertheless, this also becomes an opportunity to share the Gospel. People see the injustice and become interested in the Truth.

Tuesday – 29

Please keep praying for the FM frequency in Kazakhstan that has been promised to us for a number of years. Nurlan is in touch with officials regularly. We are not giving up hope. Nothing is impossible for God. We do believe that an FM station in Almaty would enhance our broadcasts tremendously.

Wednesday – 30

Please pray for Ardak, our IT person, who takes care of our Almaty studio needs and also works on the Kazakh web page. Especially in cities like Almaty, young people mostly listen to broadcasts on their smartphones.
